Pilot Project: Terrorisme bespreken in de klas

Internship for the TerInfo project

The municipality of Utrecht promotes an inclusive approach to issues of radicalization and polarization through the platform “Utrecht Zijn We Samen” (UZWS) [“We Are Utrecht Together”]. UZWS is a broad societal initiative build on the conviction that radicalization prevention is strongly connected to societal cohesion. Utrecht University supports UZWS in various ways, e.g. by looking at the effectiveness of the interventions that take place within the framework of UZWS, by investigating the problems of radicalization and polarization in Utrecht’s education institutes and by developing knowledge products connected to the issues at hand. Within the UZWS framework, the History of International Relations section of the UU coordinates the TerInfo project directed at schools (primary and secondary education) in Utrecht. This project entails the development of a digital-pedagogical platform to support teachers in discussing terrorism in a responsible and inclusive manner in the classroom, making use of historical knowledge and a diversity of educational resources.

The TerInfo project offers at least three internship positions for MA students to support the further development of the knowledge platform and the implementation of this project in different schools in Utrecht, building on the experience acquired during Phase I which took place during the past schoolyear. Internship activities take place in coordination with teachers and students from Information Sciences and Pedagogy and include content development and project implementation with participating schools and other stakeholders. The internship requires a 15 ects time investment and takes place between January and July 2019. **Dutch is a requirement for this internship.**
